It is great to see children back at school in time to celebrate Tongan Language week. On Friday children can wear mufti to school.

We are doing everything possible to provide a safe environment as well as providing a regular school programme with some fun additions such as a bike day for juniors and some in school sports fun. If you are still considering when to send your children back to school we hope it is soon. The Minister of Education has said it is safe for children to return to school so if you are still thinking about this, we hope we will see your children soon.

Our Level 2 plan includes:

- Reminding everyone to wash their hands and using sanitiser
- Coughing and sneezing into our elbow
- Staying away if sick
- Keeping our distance from others (in class this means no touching each other and keeping out of each other's breathing space)
- Cleaning and disinfecting our high touch surfaces daily
- Displaying QR code posters at our entrances
- Keeping a visitor register for anyone who cannot use the app.
- Your child can wear a mask but this is not compulsory. We will of course support them should they choose to do so.

For those of you who might be finding things more difficult than usual, a reminder that there is a large range of support available.
